# Sociological method from symbolic interactionist tradition

- Enteractionists: the '*interaction*' is the basic object that society and individuals are built from.
- E Careful dissection of those interactions is therefore a crucial method.

#### Repair

Interactionists: the instrumental side of interaction (communication, manipulation, persuasion, etc) is often secondary to the *situation* of the interaction.

Most important is that the interaction "works out"

E Conversation analysis tries to locate the moments when the interaction order is breaking down, and how participants work together to repair it.

### **Projected (idealized) sequence**


Opening sequence → inquiry sequence → evaluation sequence → closing sequence


#### Raw data does not allow this

- Ambiguities, omissions, technical errors, etc. complicate the fixation.
- Conversational devices are used to resolve these issues.

(procedural implicature, optical induction, and oppositive devices)
